**REQUEST FOR INTERVENTION IN OKE-ODE COMMUNITY TO BE MOVED FROM
33KV ALABE TO 33KV LINE IN ABAYAN**

The Bola Ahmed Tinubu Ideological Group (BAT-IG), on behalf of the entire Oke-Ode Community in Ifelodun Local Government Area of Kwara State, comprising of Oke-Ode, Labaka, Omi-Aro, Jubilee, Shagbe, Arola, Ologorun, Ologomo, Eri-Alhaji and Ojutaye, hereby writes to appeal that the source of electricity supply to these communities be moved from the existing 33KV line at Alabe Community to the 33KV line at Abayan Community, both in Ifelodun Local Government Area of Kwara State.

The BAT Ideological Group is a grassroots-driven sociopolitical, humanitarian, and policy-advocacy organization committed to promoting good governance, grassroots mobilization, policy support, youth empowerment, education advocacy, healthcare intervention, and national unity in alignment with the Renewed Hope agenda of the administration of President Bola Ahmed Tinubu and raising men and women who will become walking carriers of the president's political spirit. Our core values are built on service to humanity, practical community intervention, support for vulnerable populations, youth inclusion, and strengthening public confidence in government through impactful and people-oriented programs.

We note that the NCDC's mandate covers infrastructure, power, and rural development across the North Central geopolitical zone, of which Kwara State is a part. We believe this request falls squarely within the Commission's remit, and would be grateful for the Commission's support in facilitating this transition, whether directly or in collaboration with the distribution company (IBEDC).

Reason for our request:

i. Security and Vandalism Risk: The current 33KV Alabe line passes through a dense forest that serves as a hideout for criminals. This creates a constant risk of vandalism to electrical equipment and infrastructure.

ii. Difficulty in Fault Repair: Tracing and clearing electrical faults within the forest poses danger to community members and IBEDC technicians.



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
