REQUEST FOR ELECTRICITY INFRASTRUCTURE INTERVENTIONS IN SELECTED COMMUNITIES OF BENUE STATE

The Bola Ahmed Tinubu Ideological Group (BAT-IG) respectfully writes to appeal to the Rural Electrification Agency (REA) for urgent electricity infrastructure interventions in **Oglewu Ehaje Ward, Ohimini Local Government Area; Adoka Icho Ward, Otukpo Local Government Area; and Owukpa Ehaje II Ward, Ogbadibo Local Government Area, Benue State.**

The requested interventions comprise the **provision of a new transformer for Oglewu Ehaje Ward** and the **rehabilitation of electricity supply networks serving Adoka Icho Ward and Owukpa Ehaje II Ward.**

The BAT Ideological Group is a grassroots-driven sociopolitical, humanitarian, and policy-advocacy organization committed to promoting good governance, grassroots mobilization, policy support, youth empowerment, education advocacy, healthcare intervention, and national unity in alignment with the Renewed Hope agenda of the administration of President Bola Ahmed Tinubu and raising men and women who will become walking carriers of the president's political spirit. Our core values are built on service to humanity, practical community intervention, support for vulnerable populations, youth inclusion, and strengthening public confidence in government through impactful and people-oriented programs.

We recognise the critical role of the Rural Electrification Agency as the Federal Government's implementing agency for expanding electricity access and improving electricity infrastructure in unserved and underserved communities. We therefore respectfully seek the Agency's support in addressing the identified electricity challenges affecting the three communities.

1. PROVISION OF A NEW TRANSFORMER FOR OGLEWU EHAJE WARD, OHIMINI LGA

The existing transformer serving Oglewu Ehaje Ward is reportedly inadequate for the current electricity demand of the community, resulting in overload conditions, frequent trips, and interruptions in power supply.

The continued overloading of the existing equipment also places considerable stress on the transformer and associated distribution infrastructure, potentially shortening their operational lifespan
