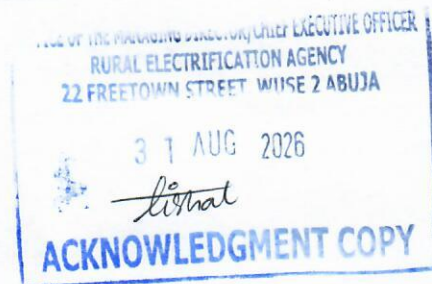

REQUEST FOR INTERVENTION TO RELOCATE OKE-ODE COMMUNITY'S SUPPLY FROM 33KV ALABE TO 33KV LINE IN ABAYAN

The Bola Ahmed Tinubu Ideological Group (BAT-IG), on behalf of the entire Oke-Ode Community in Ifelodun Local Government Area of Kwara State, comprising of Oke-Ode, Labaka, Omi-Aro, Jubilee, Shagbe, Arola, Ologorun, Ologomo, Eri-Alhaji and Ojutaye, hereby writes to appeal to the Rural Electrification Agency that the source of electricity supply to these communities be moved from the existing 33KV line at Alabe Community to the 33KV line at Abayan Community, both in Ifelodun Local Government Area of Kwara State.

As these are rural, underserved communities whose economic activity has been directly held back by unreliable power, we believe this request aligns with REA's mandate to improve access to reliable electricity in rural Nigeria. We strongly believe that moving the supply source to the 33KV line at Abayan will improve economic activities in these communities and increase revenue through a stable power supply and higher consumption.

Reason for our request:

- i. Security and Vandalism Risk:** The current 33KV Alabe line passes through a dense forest that serves as a hideout for criminals. This creates a constant risk of vandalism to electrical equipment and infrastructure.
- ii. Difficulty in Fault Repair:** Tracing and clearing electrical faults within the forest poses danger to community members and IBEDC technicians.
- iii. Frequent Power Outages:** Each time trees fall on the power line due to storms and heavy wind, or whenever it rains, the communities experience prolonged power outages. Repairing faults requires heavy security escort and the accompanying funding.
- iv. Economic Impact:** The incessant power outages have forced many artisans, craftsmen, and small-scale industries to leave the communities. This has negatively affected local development.
